We hope you had a wonderful Christmas and a great start to the New Year. We hope you are looking forward to beginning the Spring term with lots of fun learning in-store.


Our learning theme for this term is **space**. We will enjoy learning about stars and planets alongside rockets, space stations, and astronauts. We will use ambitious vocabulary in our learning, including words such as 'atmosphere', 'gravity', and 'solar system'. We will also be exploring artists, such as the composer Holst and painter Jackson Pollock, and how their work can inspire our exploration of **space**.

Our work in Maths this half-term will build upon the skills developed last term. Our mathematical themes will be comparison, composition, shape and measures.

We will continue to embed our knowledge of Phase 2 Phonics this half-term and will also learn new Phase 3 phonics. In addition, we will be learning new graphemes and tricky words, as well as practising the

This half-term, our Literacy learning focuses on writing our own adapted stories and non-fiction texts. In addition, children will use their increased phonics knowledge to support and build confidence in their writing. Our key text will be 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers.
