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
# Dear Families.

We hope you had a great half-term break and are looking forward to the second Autumn term. We have a busy half-term ahead, packed with lots of learning.

Our learning theme for this term is Transport: Past and Present. We will enjoy learning about different modes of transport and engineers. Our work in Maths this half-term will build upon the skills developed last term. Our mathematical themes will be comparison, composition, shape and measures.

We will be continuing to learn more Phase 2 phonics this half-term. In addition, we will be learning new graphemes and tricky words, as well as practising the skills of oral blending, word reading and spelling.

This half-term in Literacy focuses on comprehension, captioning and rhyming. Children will use their increased phonics knowledge to support and build confidence in their writing. Our key Talk 4 Writing text will be 'Duck in the Truck' by Jez Alborough.





As you know, our Reception learning occurs inside and outside the classroom. With the wetter weather this term, please ensure your child has a change of clothes at school and, if possible, wellies to change into when needed. In addition, please make sure you regularly check Tapestry to see the latest learning updates within Reception and how you can support your child at home.
