In **Geography** this term, we will start a new topic and will learn about The United Kingdom. In addition, we will be using maps, atlases and globes to help us to name, identify and locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom.

In **History**, we will start another new topic, Kings and Queens. We will learn about the Magna Carta, Henry III, Charles I and Oliver Cromwell and our current monarch.


In **Science**, we are learning about Seasons and Weather. We will learn to describe the weather associated with seasons and examine the changes across the four seasons.
