Our children have made a positive start to year 2, making new friends, recapping learning from year one and addressing new learning areas. We have a fun and exciting half-term planned. The children will be learning about a range of subjects, including **History** - The Romans, **Art** - Exploring colour in paintings and sculpture, **Science** - Human body, **Design & Technology** - Designing and building a Ferris Wheel.

English - Our class text is *George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl*. We are learning an extract from the book for Talk4Writing and making up actions to help us remember it. In this unit, we will be consolidating how to use full stops and capital letters consistently and correctly, focusing on spelling common exception words and learning to use expanded noun phrases to enhance the descriptions in our writing. Maths - We start this term with place value, consolidating our understanding of tens and ones, and learning how to identify and manipulate them. We are also developing our skills to read and write numbers as words to 100. Once we have completed this unit, we will take our understanding of place value and apply it to addition and subtraction. 
