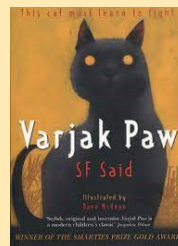

Dear Families,

We are, as always, incredibly proud of the work Year 4 has achieved this year. We have been learning, building, and creating in many different forms. The children continue to show exemplary behaviour and pride in their work. Without a doubt, we are looking forward to yet another exciting half-term.

Maths: During the summer term, we will continue focusing on decimals, where we will develop the skill to add, takeaway and convert them from other representations. We will also look at money and how we may work out the change.

English: We will be continuing to focus on the core text 'Varjak Paw' for our Reading unit, an exciting story about the adventures of a fearless Mesopotamian blue cat. The children will be exploring new vocabulary, inferring about the characters and what goes on in the mind of a cat in the outside world. We look forward to delving into this story further this coming term.



Science: This term, we will focus on states of matter, looking at precipitation, evaporation, and the water cycle. Children will investigate and experiment with how states of matter can change due to environmental alterations.



Geography: During the summer term, children will be embedding engaging new learning about London and the Southeast regions of England. We will continue to explore the human and non-human features, extend our map-reading skills and link our historical knowledge of the Romans to facts about London.

Across the other subjects: We will also focus on The Stuarts with our History unit and, in Art, create various mosaics associated with the Byzantine Empire.
