Dear Families,

We hope you have had a good half-term break and are looking forward to our final Summer term, with lots of fun learning in-store.

Our learning theme for this half term is 'Stories from the past'. We will learn about fairytales, fables, folk tales, myths and legends! Children will explore a diverse range of stories across different countries and cultures and different time periods. Children will encounter various characters,



adventures and new vocabulary across the stories we explore.

Our work in **Maths** this half-term will build upon previously developed skills, deeply exploring numbers and concepts. Our key mathematical theme is pattern. We will look at doubling, sharing and grouping, odd and even numbers, patterns and relationships, and spatial reasoning.

We will continue to secure our previously taught knowledge of Phase 2 and 3 **Phonics** and embed Phase 4. We will gain further confidence in reading words, including longer words, words with adjacent consonants, and tricky words.

This half-term, our **Literacy** learning focuses on strengthening our confidence and abilities in writing. This will include applying our



growing phonics knowledge to segment and identify graphemes to write, using key writing features of capital letters, finger spaces, and full stops, and ensuring our handwriting is well-formed and can be read by ourselves and others. Our key text will be 'Little Red Riding Hood'. After exploring the text deeply, we will look at inventing our own stories!


