Staffing Changes for January 2023

Now that all the details have been finalised, I can update you on staff appointments and arrangements across Raleigh Infant and Admirals Academies for January 2023.

- Mrs Purvis will join the staff of Norwich Road Academy, which is also part of Eastern Multi Academy Trust. She will join Norwich Road Academy for the remainder of the Academic year to support the leadership team by fulfilling the role of Deputy Principal and class teacher in Year 3.
- In the absence of Mrs Purvis, Mrs Natalie Ewens will take on leadership responsibility across the entire infant age range. She will continue in her role as English subject leader across both Academies and remain a teacher to Beagle class.
