Dear Families,


We hope you had a refreshing half-term break and are looking forward to the second Autumn term. We have a busy half-term ahead, packed with lots of fun learning!

Our learning theme for this term is 'Transport: Past and Present'. We will enjoy learning about transport around the world, transportation in the past, present and future, road safety, and some key engineers.

Our work in **Maths** this half term will build upon the skills developed in Autumn 1. Our key mathematical themes will include:

- Developing our counting and subitising skills.
- Identifying the composition of numbers.
- Comparing amounts.

We will be continuing to learn more **Phase 2 Phonics** this half term. We will be learning new graphemes and tricky words, as well as practising the skills of oral blending, word reading and spelling.



In this half-term in **Literacy**, we focus on comprehension, captioning and rhyming. Children will use their increased phonics knowledge to support and build confidence in their writing. Our key text will be '**Duck in the Truck**' by Jez Alborough.



Our learning takes place both inside and outside of the classroom. With the wetter weather, please ensure your child has a coat, a change of clothes at school, and if possible wellies to change into when needed.


Home Learning
