Dear Families,

Happy New Year. We hope you had a festive Christmas and a sparkly New Year.

This first half of the spring term in English, our class texts will be Coming to England by Floella Benjamin. This is the true story of how 11-year-old Floella Benjamin arrived in England in 1960

from Trinidad to start a new life in London. The Street Beneath My Feet by Charlotte Guillain. This book takes you on a fascinating journey down through the layers of the Earth, all the way to the planet's core and out the other side. We will also be reading The Quangle Wangle's Hat by Edward Lear, a nonsense poem that describes how a Quangle Wangle is no longer lonely once canaries and several other animals build homes in his enormous hat. We will be writing our own humorous poems, a formal invitation and a nonchronological report. We will focus on different sentence types, subordinating



conjunctions and technical vocabulary.

In maths, the children are introduced to multiplication and will learn the two, five and ten times tables. We will then begin an introduction to division, where division calculations can be used to represent grouping problems.

In **RE** this term, the children will be learning about Judaism with a focus on Passover. We will answer the question: How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do? We will also explore how celebrating Passover helps Jews show God they value their special relationship with Him.

In **geography**, the children will be learning about the British Isles. We will look at the link between the geography of a place and its human features. We will learn about the countries of the British Isles and become familiar with their key geographical features, including the mountains and valleys in Wales and the Giant's Causeway in Northern Ireland.

In history, we will be taking part in the Thetford Heritage Project. We will learn about Allan Glaisyer Minns, the first elected black mayor in Great Britain. Minns served two oneyear terms as mayor of Thetford from 1904 to 1906.
