Dear Families,

Year 3 had an excellent first term, exploring many new skills in subjects, which we plan to build on this term. This half term, we will be covering a range of subjects and topics as outlined below:



Science:

In Science, we will focus on how rocks are formed, the different types of rocks, and where we can find them. We will use scientific skills to experiment and explore different rocks around us.

Geography:

In Geography this half term, we will learn about rivers. We will explore and investigate the features of rivers, some of which may be close and local, compared to others further away. We will be gaining geographical skills to help us discuss the reasons why particular rivers may have different features from others. This will also support children with their Geography homework project.



History:

In History, we will learn about the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings by exploring important timelines and learning the names of key people who lived in this time. We will begin to test our knowledge and skill as historians as we begin to piece together previous learning into this unit of work.
