Dear Families,

Welcome back. We hope you had a lovely week off and enjoyed some sunshine in the rain!

This half-term, although short, will be packed with lots of fabulous learning.

In this half of the Spring term, our class text in **English** will be **Here We Are: Notes For Living On Planet Earth by Oliver Jeffers.** The book takes the reader on a tour of planet Earth, providing an overview of the sea, the land, the sky, our bodies and the different people and animals that inhabit the planet. We will also be reading **Chocolate Cake by Michael Rosen**. The poem tells the story of Michael sneaking downstairs in the middle of the night to nibble at a big chocolate cake his mother had made. In writing, we will be writing a story with a familiar setting. We will also be writing a recount of our trip to the beach!





In **maths**, children are introduced to addition and subtraction below 10. We will be exploring what this means in depth. We will look at different representations and methods to solve our problems. We will also story-tell using addition and subtraction.

In **geography**, we are continuing our unit of The UK. In **history**, we are continuing to our unit of kings and queens.

In **science**, we are starting a new topic of **seasons and weather**. We will be monitoring the weather for the whole half-term. We will use equipment such as wind vanes and rain gauges to monitor the weather and record this. We will also be looking at dangerous weather in the world.

We will use 'Carnival of the Animals' by Saint-Saëns as a stimulus in music. We explore the movements of the work and how instrumentation, dynamics, tempo and pitch are used to convey different animals and the way they move.
