Family, Royal buildings,




Coronations, our Government, and more! As we grow our knowledge, we will learn and use a range of new vocabulary.

We will continue to embed our previously taught knowledge of Phase 2 and 3 **Phonics** and begin to explore **Phase 4** Phonics. We will gain further confidence in reading words, including longer words, words with adjacent consonants, and tricky words.

This half-term our **Literacy** learning focuses on strengthening our confidence and abilities in writing, continuing to write stories, and furthering our knowledge of list and letter writing. Our key text will be '**The Princess and the Pea**' by Rachel Isadora.
