Dear Families,


Welcome back. We hope you had a lovely long break and enjoyed some chocolate!

I'm excited for a longer half-term to allow us time to consolidate all our learning. This is a very important half-term for us regarding phonics. We will be reviewing all learnt sounds from reception up until the last half-term. This is our revision for the phonics screening check, which is due to take place the **week commencing June 10th.** Please continue to complete the phonics homework

weekly, which will help consolidate all the previous sounds taught.

This first half of the spring term, we will be reading **'There's a Rang-Tan in my bedroom.'** This book explores the destruction of orangutans' habitats and what we can do to help.





and We will also be reading 'and **tango makes three'.** The book

introduces pupils to the idea that families can look different but are still be bound together by love. We will explore and write our poems and what it means to be a poet. We will also write an informal letter, which is a task we've done before, so it will be exciting to see how these letters compare.

In **maths**, we will be continuing to explore our addition and subtraction facts within 10. we will explore place value with numbers under 20. We will be looking at position and direction exploring the language used.

In geography, we will look at the seven continents and the five oceans.

In **history**, we are looking at parliament and prime ministers through time until the present day,

In **science**, we are looking at Taking Care of the Earth. Within this unit, we included knowledge that, over time, builds an understanding of concepts such as recycling and sustainability. We will build awareness of local and global issues concerning the environment.
