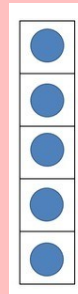


Literacy

Our literacy program will feature a diverse range of fiction and non-fiction books that tie in with our theme, 'All About Me'. We will also be engaging in the joy of nursery rhymes and the beauty of poems. In our literacy sessions, we will be running a 'Drawing Club' to enhance fine motor skills, creativity, and early writing skills. Our key texts for this term will be 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears', and 'A Squash and A Squeeze'.

Maths

We focus on numbers up to 3 using fingers, pictures, songs and five frames. We are developing a deeper understanding of numbers, ensuring children are confident. We will look at 2D shapes, find shapes in the environment, arrange shapes, and sort by size and colour.
