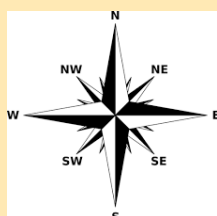
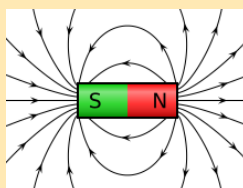


Dear Families,

We hope that you have had an enjoyable summer and are looking forward to the autumn term. This half term, we will be covering a range of subjects and topics—some of which are outlined below:

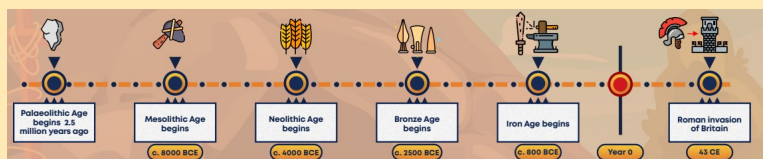
Science:

In Science we will be focusing on the knowledge of magnets and forces. Children will investigate and explore these ideas with different forms of magnets and exploring magnetic fields and its strength.



Geography:
