


Dear Families,

## Maths:

We will be learning about numbers up to 10 million (10,000,000) and drawing and decomposing different shapes. Our maths work will also include revisiting previous topics and our times tables. If your child is struggling with maths, please use the CGP homework books provided by the school, as they contain lots of information that can help your children.



## English:

In English, the children will read *Pig Heart Boy* by Malorie Blackman, a powerful story about friendship, loyalty, and family. The children continue to build on their reading skills, such as summarising, inference, and retrieval.
