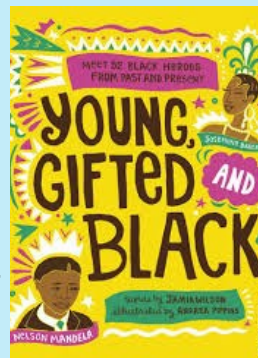

Reading

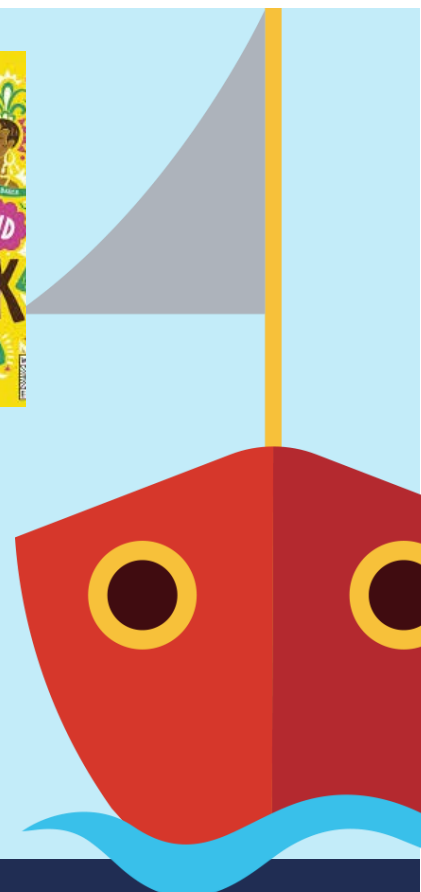
