

English

Writing:

In our Writing lessons, the children will be learning how to write an effective story, written in the 'first person', a concept which places them as the main character in their story. We will then move on to write newspaper reports, focusing on the layout, language and purpose of the text.



Reading:

In our Reading lessons, the children will be reading the book called 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman – a powerful story about friendship, loyalty and family. The children are continuing to build on their reading skills, such as summarising, inference and retrieval.

We will be learning about numbers up to 10 million (10,000,000), as well as learning how to add, subtract and multiply fractions.


Our Maths work will also include revisiting previous learning and revisiting our times tables.

Spelling Frame
