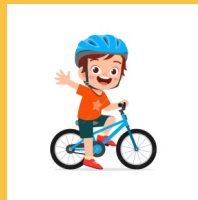
Welcome

Wider Curriculum

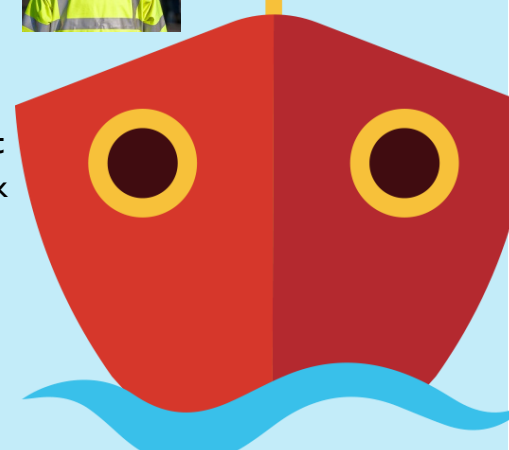
Our learning theme for this half term is **Heroes and Adventurers**. To start with we will be learning about adventurers such as **astronauts** and how they ventured into **space**. Next, we will be revisiting some previous learning such as, **people in our community** who help us and the explorer **Ernest Shackleton**. We will be extending our knowledge by learning about people who climbed **mountains**. Finally, we will end with **reflecting** on ourselves and thinking about our **talents and achievements** both at home and in nursery.

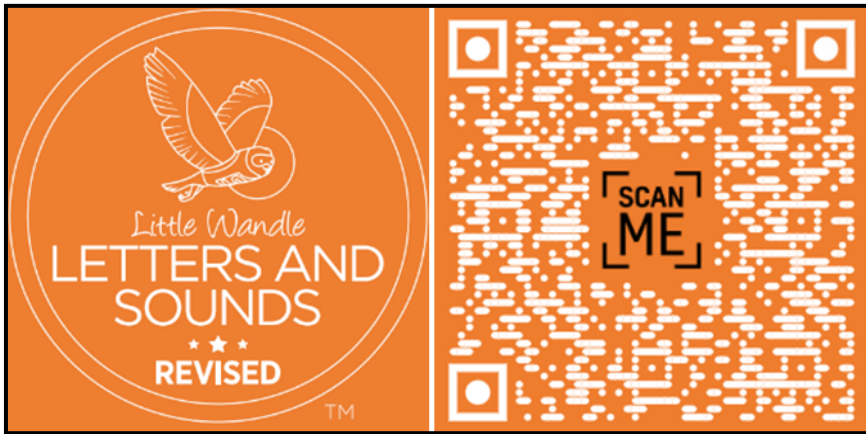


In **Art** we will be creating **sculptures of the Explorer Ernest Shackleton** using **clay**. Also, we will be creating pictures to link with our PKC theme using chalk, paint and pencils.



In **RE** we will be learning about **special places** such as **churches and mosques** and how different cultures use their special places.





Phonics

We will be continuing to embed our knowledge of our early **Phonics**, recalling previous sounds as well as learning new ones, **sh, th, ng, nk, ck**. We will be practicing the skills of oral blending and playing different phonic games to develop these skills as well as introducing the word 'digraph' (two letters that make one sound). Regular practice will support your child with the previous and current sounds learnt, this is good preparation for children heading into reception.

Our Key Focus



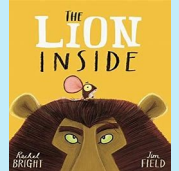
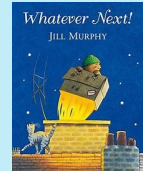

- Track upcoming dates for transitions and events such as sports day.

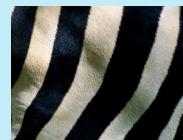
Literacy



In **Literacy**, we use 'Drawing Club' to develop children's fine motor skills, creative thinking, alongside their writing. Our key texts this half term will be '**Supertato** By Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet, **Whatever Next** by Jill Murphy and **The Lion Inside** by Rachel Bright. Children will be encouraged to retell stories and make marks/ pictures to represent these stories as well and use their imaginations to create their own. You can help by sharing stories at home, this can be with any book or the school library books to develop the love of reading.

Mathematics

In **Maths** this half term, to start with, we will be learning about patterns, looking closely at animals and creating our own repeating patterns, next we will be learning positional language and finally, we will be revisiting areas of our maths during the year to embed further.
