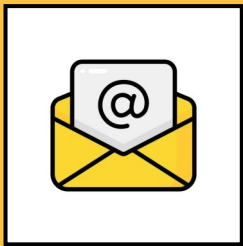

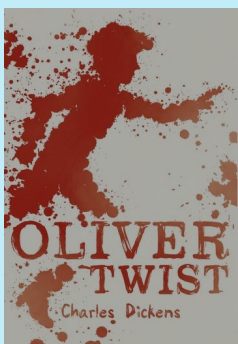

English

Writing:

In our writing lessons, Year 6 children will be practising the grammar and sentence structures they have learned throughout primary school. We will be writing a leaflet on their time in Year 6 and a scientific report on Evolution. In the last few weeks we will also be writing our leaver's speech ready for assembly.



Reading:

In our reading lessons, Year 6 children will be reading and unpicking the archaic language written in the story of Oliver Twist, by Charles Dickens. We will be practising the key reading skills, for example ordering different statements about a text, inferring information about a character's actions and drawing evidence to back up a point.

Mathematics

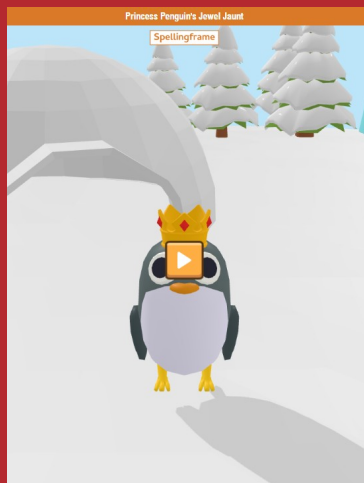
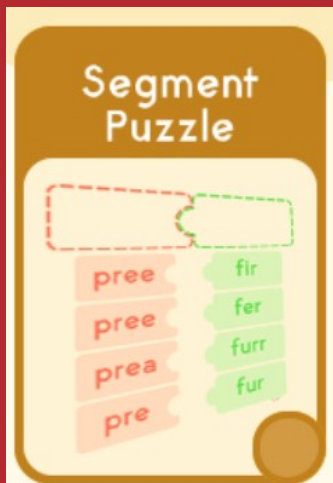
This term, children will be practising and refining their mathematical skills in order to prepare them for Year 7 maths at secondary school.

For example, we will be revising money word problems, general arithmetic methods and applying prior learning to a range of questions. If your child is struggling, please ensure they practise at home, using resources e.g. their Maths Revision Guide, any useful videos and step-by-step guidance websites (BBC Bitesize).

History

In History, children will be learning about Human Rights around the world and in the UK. They will look at particular Human Right movements such as that of the Suffragette Movement.
